



BLUE SHOCK RACE 2015

In 2015, Blue Shock Race attracts a private investor Jānis Krastiņš, who invests in total 10,000 euros for development of test prototype in order to ensure that it is possible at all to develop an electric kart, which could demonstrate performance of race kart, and that there is any potential in it.

Mārtiņš Sesks invested his last karting season's race chassis "Gillard", which served for the prototype as a test, whereas Mārtiņš himself became a test pilot in Liepāja, taking the first test drives in order to give suggestions on the performance and dynamics of the kart.
